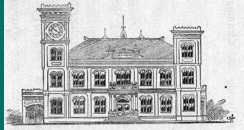

A message from your Chairman: Sen. Troy A. Carter



We are so thrilled for the people of Algiers that the [New Orleans Regional Transit Authority](#) has been awarded a roughly \$2.4 million federal grant to "modernize" the ferry terminal in Algiers. The grant comes as the transit agency prepares to tear down the connecting downtown ferry terminal at the foot of Canal Street and build a new one, as well as bring a pair of [new ferry boats](#) into service.

Trasdev officials held two public meetings last year to seek input from Algiers stakeholders about improvements they'd like to see for the terminal. We are happy to see that many of those [suggestions from Algiers residents](#) made their way into the grant proposal.

New ferry boats are still under construction, but we can expect to see a new vessel on the river as early as Summer of 2018 with a second to follow about six months later.
