Dempsey brings immense experience in board and organization development, financial management, federal grant administration, and strategic planning to the ADD board. Dempsey came to New Orleans with the Marine Corps in 1998. As a long time property owner and resident of Algiers Point, she aims to support and improve the quality of life for all of Algiers.

→ Introducing New Board Member: Daniela Rivero Bryant

Daniela Rivero Bryant is an Economics Ph.D. Candidate at Tulane University and the recipient of a National Science Foundation Graduate Research Fellowship. Her work relies on economic theory and statistical science to measure resilience, quantify the impact of natural disasters on cities and individuals, and analyze recovery policy.



Before joining the PhD program at Tulane, Daniela was part of the Louisiana Land Trust's executive team, where she coordinated the statewide disposition and reuse of thousands of Katrina-damaged properties. Prior to that, she used her engineering skills to support the post-Katrina housing recovery in New Orleans. Her efforts as Field Operations Director and later Executive Director of the nonprofit organization Rebuilding Together resulted in the reconstruction of over one thousand homes in the city's most vulnerable communities.
