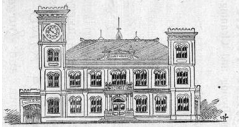

The 37,000-square-foot facility is slated to open in May 2021 at the corner of Shirley Drive and Constellation Street in Algiers, on the West Bank Campus of Delgado Community College.

\$15,000 Grants Available for Louisiana Businesses Affected by COVID-19

The Louisiana Legislature set aside \$300 million of the federal COVID-19 relief money specifically for Louisiana's small businesses. Owners of businesses affected by the pandemic need to prepare now for the grant application process. **Have your paperwork ready and apply early. These grants will go quickly.**

- 1 First grants will go to businesses that did not receive a Payroll Protection Program loan, an insurance payment or an Economic Injury Disaster Loan
- 2 \$40 million set aside for businesses owned by women, minorities and veterans
- 3 Application process starts July 28

To be eligible businesses must:

- Have 50 or fewer employees
- Be at least 50% owned by a Louisiana residents
- Suffered an interruption
- Have filed Louisiana taxes in 2018 or 2019 or will file in 2020

Grants will cover costs associated with meeting public health requirements include

- Cleaning and disinfecting
- Creating social distancing
- Buying new equipment
- Re-opening expenses

Business interruption costs covered including

- Unemployment insurance costs
- Providing sick leave
- Replacing inventory
- Rent, payroll, utilities
