



## New Orleans Maritime and Military Academy Update



While the pandemic introduced serious challenges, especially around reopening plans, NOMMA has done a fantastic job of overcoming and managing these obstacles. Summer kept the NOMMA staff busy assessing the last school year and making plans for improvements in the 2020-2021 school year. Due to its outstanding reputation and increasing demand in enrollment, NOMMA did not have to actively recruit for new students for the current term.

Today, there are over 1000 cadets enrolled in grades 8-12, a number 10 times larger than the school's original enrollment 10 years ago as its roots have deepened in our community. NOMMA maintained a 94% graduation rate this past school year and is the top performing open-enrollment school in Orleans and surrounding parishes. NOMMA Commandant Col. Chris Schlafer, stated that "NOMMA has a diverse and talented corps of cadets, with students coming from multiple parishes to attend our school. We maintain a high standard for academics and character development."

Plans to expand the physical campus to serve more students in the community and develop relationships with area colleges are underway. "We are in discussions with ADD regarding campus expansion plans. My vision for NOMMA is to be a city, state and nationally recognized educational institution right here in Federal City," Col. Schlafer said.
