## State Funding Reaps Benefits for Algiers Area Organizations *Algiers Development District Lauds Efforts of Local Legislators and Board Members*



Several Algiers organizations were direct beneficiaries of successful efforts securing funding to improve social services and the quality of life for area residents, according to Mark Major, Chair of the Algiers Development District. This funding request was submitted by Senator Gary Carter who had the assistance of the Algiers State Representatives, Delisha Boyd & Jacob Braud in obtaining support and approval in the House.

Local church programs received funding to support “human needs and assistance” initiatives through legislative Acts 170 and 397, in addition to funding for the New Orleans Recreation Department (NORD) and the “Don’t Trash Algiers” campaign, an initiative of the Algiers Neighborhood President’s Council.

“Senator Carter, along with Representatives Boyd and Braud continue to show tremendous leadership for the people of Algiers and a real sensitivity to the needs of our community. I know my fellow Development District Commissioners join me in expressing my most sincere appreciation for their tireless efforts on our behalf,” said Major. As stipulated in Carter’s

legislation, all funds appropriated through these legislative Acts were managed by ADD for distribution to the recipient organizations.

Churches poised to expand their community assistance programs including support for housing, assistance with utility payments and other quality-of-life enhancements are central to how these funds were distributed by each church.

According to Yvonne Mitchell Grubb, President of the Algiers Neighborhood President's Association, "The funds provided by Sen. Gary Carter through the Algiers Development District has enabled The Algiers Neighborhood Presidents Council to launch the "Don't Trash Algiers" campaign. This grassroots effort to reduce littering and clean up dump sites seeks to improve the quality of life for all of our residents. We hope that everyone who sees our signs, ads and clean sites understands that it is up to us to maintain our quality of life in Algiers."

Funding for NORD received in the amount of \$300,000 over three years, has been instrumental in improving its recreation offerings in Algiers, including



significant renovations at the Norman, Donsereaux Harrison and Morris Jeff facilities in Algiers. According to Larry Barabino, Jr., CEO of the NORD Commission, "Funding received through ADD has allowed us to renovate a fire damaged concession building, tennis center and two restroom buildings, upgrade basketball and tennis courts, add Pickleball courts at Morris Jeff (Behrman) and so much more. The residents of Algiers are the direct beneficiaries of these much-needed improvements, and we continue to be grateful to ADD and to Senator Carter and Representative Boyd and Braud for their work in making these upgrades possible."
